Our strategy since 2006:


VISICH ZERO. Keiner kommt um. Alle kommen an.

- Increase safety of motorcyclists
- Increase safety through improvement of infrastructure
- Promote ADAS, crosslinking and automated driving

- Increase safety of pedestrians and cyclists
- Prevent driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs
- Enhance the qualification of novice drivers
- Reduce hazards through distraction










Adjust speed limits










